

DOCKER FOR A DAY COMPETITION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering the “Docker for a Day” Competition (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. STANDARD TERMS

- 1.1 Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. The promotion is in no way endorsed or administered by, or associated with Facebook.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

- 2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all children between five and twelve (inclusive) years of age as at Monday 13 March, 2017 living in Western Australia. A parent or guardian must enter the competition on behalf of their child.
- 2.2 Employees and their immediate families of Seven Network (Operations) Limited and the Fremantle Football Club and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to win.

3. HOW TO ENTER

- 3.1 The Competition commences on Thursday 16 March 2017 at 5.00pm (Perth time) and concludes on Monday 14 August at 10.00am (Perth time) (“Competition Period”).
- 3.2 To enter, a parent or guardian must enter the competition on behalf of their child (between the ages of five and twelve) via the Channel 7 Perth Facebook page. They must upload a picture of their child, state their child’s name, age and send via Channel 7 Perth Facebook private messenger. Photos must demonstrate their child is a Fremantle Dockers fan. No person other than the eligible child should appear in any uploaded photo. Any child depicted must be decently presented and attired. No nude or offensive images are permitted.
- 3.3 The entrant in the Competition must be aged between five and twelve (inclusive) years old as at Monday 13 March 2017.
- 3.4 Entrants in the Competition may enter as many times as they like provided each entry has a different picture; however, they can only win once.
- 3.5 Competition entry must be by a parent or guardian and with the approval of each parent and/or guardian of the child.
- 3.6 An Entrant’s picture will be displayed and publicly available on the Channel 7 Perth Facebook page at the discretion of Channel Seven Perth. The Promoter and Sponsor reserve the right to remove any image that is deemed offensive, defamatory or otherwise inappropriate.

3.7 You must own the copyright in any photograph you upload or otherwise be entitled to use the photograph in this way. By entering a child you grant the Promoter and Sponsor an irrevocable perpetual worldwide license to use the image submitted in any media for any purpose without further reference to you.

4.3 The individual prize value is \$480.91 (excluding GST). The total prize pool value is \$5,290.01. Prize values are correct as at the date of printing. The Promoters accept no responsibility for change in prize values between now and the ultimate date on which prizes are taken.

4.4 Prize winners’ parents or guardians are responsible for all other expenses including cost of travel to Domain Stadium on game day. Any expenses not expressly mentioned in these terms and conditions are the responsibility of the winner’s family.

4.5 The winner of the prize must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when participating in the prize.

4.6 In accepting the prizes, the winners’ parents or guardians agree for the winners to participate and co-operate as required in all editorial activities relating to the Competition, including but not limited to being interviewed and photographed. The winners (and their companions) agree to grant the Promoters a perpetual and exclusive licence to use such footage and photographs in all media worldwide and the winners (and their companions) will not be entitled to any fee for such use.

4.7 The winners and their parents or guardians agree they will not (and will ensure that their companions do not) sell or otherwise provide their stories and/or photographs to any media or other organisation.

- 5.2 All entries received up to judgment time will be considered. Winners will be chosen based on the pictures provided showing they are a Fremantle Dockers fan. Entries will be judged on creativity and application of the brief.
- 5.3 The winning entrant will be contacted directly via Facebook messenger requesting further details. If the entrant does not respond within 3 working days, the prize will be forfeited.
- 5.4 The judge’s decision is final and the Promoters will not enter into correspondence regarding the result.
- 5.5 It is a condition of accepting the prize that the winners (and their parents, guardians and/or companions) must comply with all the conditions of use of the prize and prize supplier’s requirements.
- 5.6 It is a condition of accepting the prize that the winners’ parents or guardians may be required to sign legal releases on behalf of their child in a form determined by the Promoters in their absolute discretion.

- 5.7 The Promoters may in their absolute discretion deem entries invalid subsequently to a winner's name being announced if it is discovered that the winner did not enter the Competition in accordance with these terms and conditions, or does not otherwise comply with these terms and conditions.
- 5.8 Prize must be taken on the date specified in clause 5.1. Any prizes not taken by the specified dates will be forfeited.

 - c) the photograph is not and will not be defamatory or otherwise contrary to law, and Seven Network Operation's use of the photograph on the terms of this agreement will not infringe the rights (including rights of confidence) of any third party.

- 7.1 The Parent/Guardian entering the competition on behalf of their child grants to the Promoter and Sponsor a perpetual and non-exclusive license to use the photograph in all media worldwide and acknowledges that that there is no entitlement to any fee for such use.
- 7.2 The Promoter or Sponsor may modify the photograph, provided that it is modified reasonably and not in a manner which is prejudicial to the child or the parent or legal guardian's reputation.
- 7.3 The Parent/Guardian entering the competition on behalf of their child acknowledges that the public will have the capacity to comment on the uploaded photographs, and will not hold the Promoter or Sponsor liable for the publication of any comment, whether derogatory, offensive, racist, defamatory or otherwise, posted in relation to the photograph.

8. NO LIABILITY

- 8.1 In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders the Promoters' ability to proceed with the Competition on the dates and in the manner described in these terms and conditions, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, the Promoters may in their absolute discretion cancel the Competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions.
